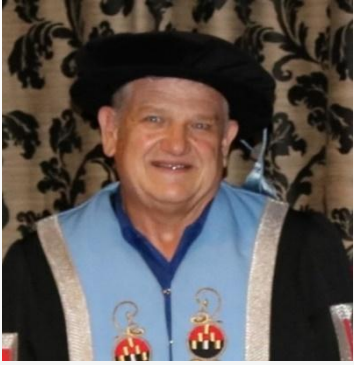

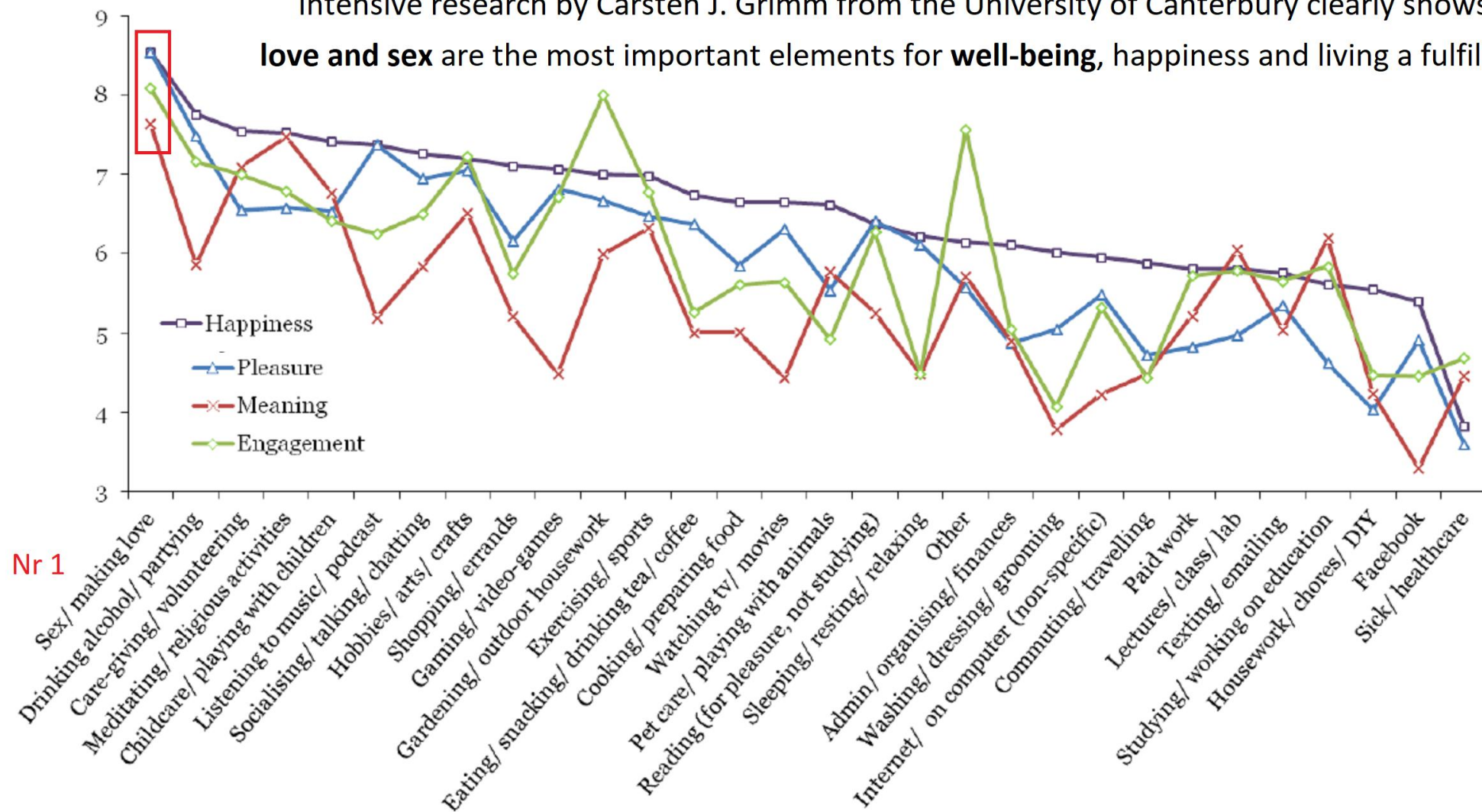

Intensive research by Carsten J. Grimm from the University of Canterbury clearly shows that **love and sex** are the most important elements for **well-being**, happiness and living a fulfilling life.

## What is Sexology?

Sexology can be described as the scientific studies of sexuality, but what is sexuality?

### 1. World Health Organisation (2000) on Sexuality

“Sexuality is a central aspect of being human throughout life and encompasses sex, gender identities and roles, sexual orientation, eroticism, pleasure, intimacy and reproduction. Sexuality is experienced and expressed in thoughts, fantasies, desires, beliefs, attitudes, values, behaviours, practices, roles and relationships. Sexuality is influenced by the interaction of biological, psychological, social, economic, political, cultural, ethical, legal, historical and religious and spiritual factors” (WHO, 2000) and (WAS, 2007).

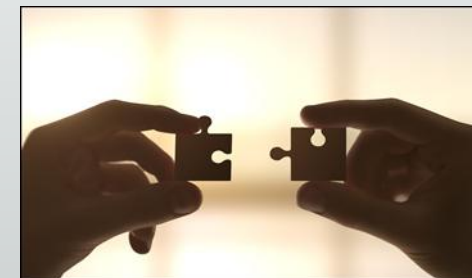
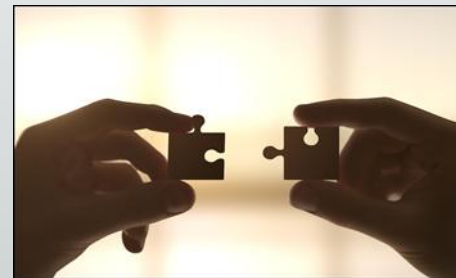
### 2. Sexology Epistemologically-Scientifically Grounded

“Sexology is the scientific study of the individual and collective sexual being and behaviour (procreation, relation and recreation) with a unique w-holistic, universal integralistic (bio-psycho-socio-cultural), inter-transactional (trans-disciplinary) theory and an own methodology and unique field of study aimed at between and beyond the poles praxis theories as outcomes”. Lemmer 2005a, 2011a, 2011b.

### 3. The World Health Organisation (2000) on Sexology

“As an interdisciplinary science, sexology is uniquely placed to bring together the knowledge and expertise of specialists, the diverse agendas of various advocacy groups, the health concerns of communities, and the methodologies and interests of diverse disciplines.

*“For this reason, it is critical that sexology is promoted as a discipline/profession. It is not sufficient for specialists from other disciplines to apply their fields of expertise to the study of Sexual Health”*. WHO 2000 p.28.



## South Africa sets the example with the CSHP as Professional Body for Sexual Health Professionals

### QUALIFICATIONS lead to DESIGNATIONS:

The CSHP is the *Professional Body* in South Africa where our graduandi register to practice legally as sexuality counsellors (NQF 8 level), -therapists (NQF 9 level) and sexologists (NQF 10 level). Our graduandi play a significant role in sexual health and well-being in South Africa. Most (but not all) professionals at the CSHP received their training from the Academy of Sexology International. ### The CSHP as PROFESSIONAL BODY in South Africa:

- 1) The CSHP is a legally constituted entity with the necessary human and financial resources to undertake its functions, governed by a constitution and compliant with and adhere to good corporate governance practices.
- 2) The CSHP protects the public interest in relation to services provided by its members and the associated risks.
- 3) The CSHP develop, award, monitor and revoke its professional designations in terms of its own rules and international conventions.
- 4) The Professional Code of Conduct of the CSHP is based on the code of conduct drawn up by the World Health Organization Helsinki 6 June 2009.
- 5) The CSHP keeps a fully updated list/record of members.
- 6) The CSHP set criteria for, promote and monitor continuing professional development (CPD) for its category
- 7) Recognition of prior learning (RPL) is a priority of the CSHP. All members must meet the relevant professional designation requirements of sexologist, therapist- of sexuality and counsellor of sexuality.
- 8) The CSHP do have a published code of conduct and do operate a mechanism for investigating members who are alleged to have contravened the code.

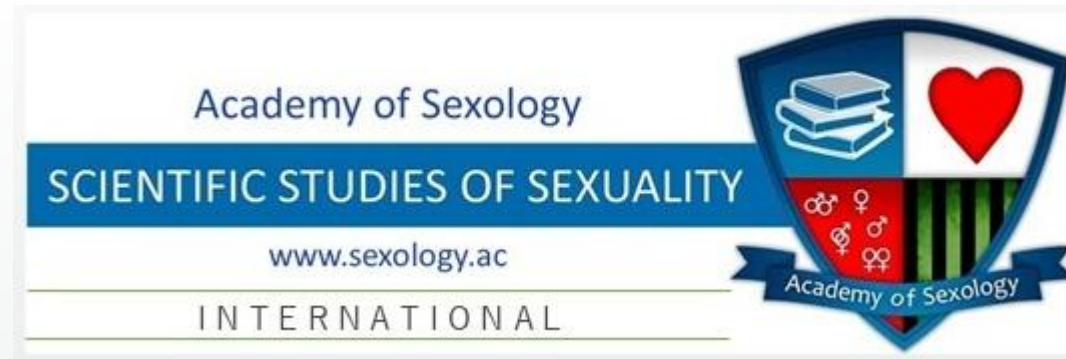
